RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide direct leadership and supervision to participants aged 6-14 years old attending the Strathcona Supershine Summer Day Camp
- Plan, organize and lead children in out-trips, sports, games, arts, crafts, music and educational activities
- Follow established risk management guidelines to ensure a safe, inclusive environment for all day camp participants, volunteers and staff
- With the support of the Project Manager, provide guidance, supervision and feedback to program volunteers
- Mentor, train, and provide constructive feedback to Junior Day Camp Leaders
- Develop positive relationships to effectively communicate with co-workers, volunteers, parent/caretakers, and participants
- Maintain and reconcile weekly petty cash funds
- Provide first aid and complete administrative duties as required

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Completion of grade 12 or equivalent
- Previous experience working with large groups of children, preferably in a day camp setting
- Knowledge and ability to plan, lead, and motivate children in a range of age-appropriate recreational activities
- Proven team player, with ability to take initiative and problem solve
- Strong sense of responsibility, maturity, and a positive attitude
- Valid Standard/Emergency First Aid and CPR C certification
- Post-secondary education or training in a related field is an asset
- Certifications in Food Safe, High Five, Play It Fair, NCCP or other related trainings are an asset
- Fluency in additional language(s) an asset
